Tá bliain eile imithe uainn agus ceiliúradh na Nollag faoi cheo na cuimhne ach níor chóir go gcuirfeadh seo lagmhisneach orainn óir tá neart imeachtaí agus siamsaíochta beartaíthe againn anseo le fáilte hearta a chur roimh an Earrach i gcoiláir na Ceathrún Gaeltachta. Tá beocht san aer ag an am seo bliana agus beannaíonn muid don ghrian i ndiaidh an gheimhridh fhuair dhorchá. Leanfar lenár gclár rannpháirteachais ealaíon, Airneál na nÓg agus Cumann Ealaíne na Cultúrlainne. Cuireann muid béim ar an chomhpháirtíocht agus tá lúcháir orainn cur leis an chaidreamh láidir atá tógtha againn le Young at Art agus muid ag comhoibriú leo arís i mbliana ar Fhéile Pháistí Bhéal Feirste. Tá tionscadal úrnua idir lámha againn don fhéile sin i mbliana, athinsint ar an tseanscéal, Mír agus Éadaoin. Idir sin, seoltaí albam agus Féile an Earraigh, beidh rud ann do chách agus beidh fearadh na fáilte romhaibh a bheith linn.



Another year has passed and the Christmas celebrations are now a distant memory but we shouldn't be disheartened because we have a full programme of events to welcome in the Spring in the heart of Belfast's emerging Gaeltacht Quarter. 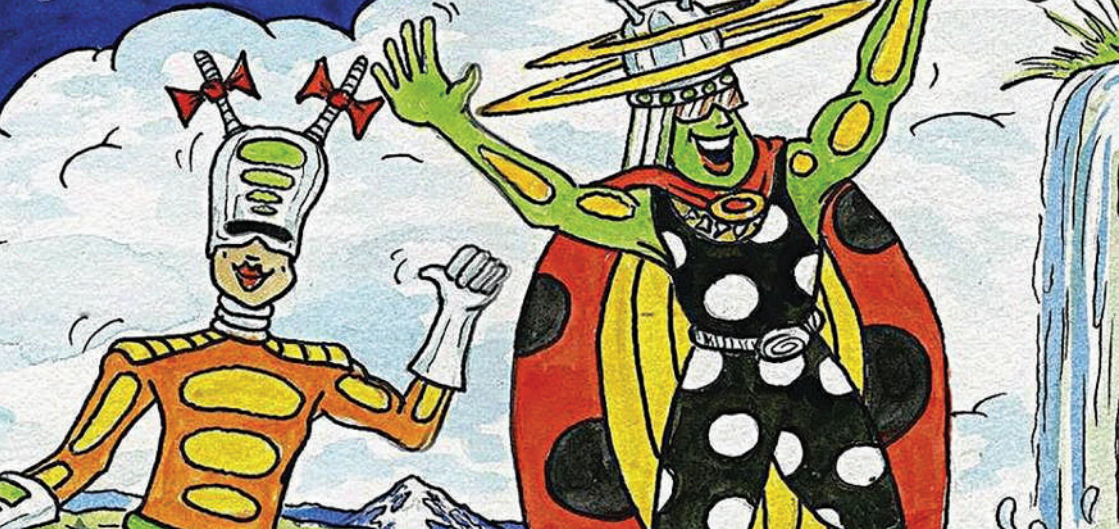

As we celebrate International Women’s Day, it is very fitting that Professor Fionntán de Brún takes us through the extraordinary life of Maighréad Nic Mhaicín, an intelligent and brave woman whose full story is yet to be told. The talk will be interspersed with the gorgeous voice of Róisie Nic Corraídh.

Before the First World War and still a teenager, Maighréad Nic Mhaicín began working in the mill on the Falls Road. She wrote a short story, “An Scilling” in which she described the mill worker’s hardships. Maighréad didn’t stay in the mills, she became proficient in numerous languages and worked in Moscow as a translator where she translated notable Russian works to Irish for publisher An Gúm. Maighread’s husband died in Russia in one of Stalin’s concentration camps.

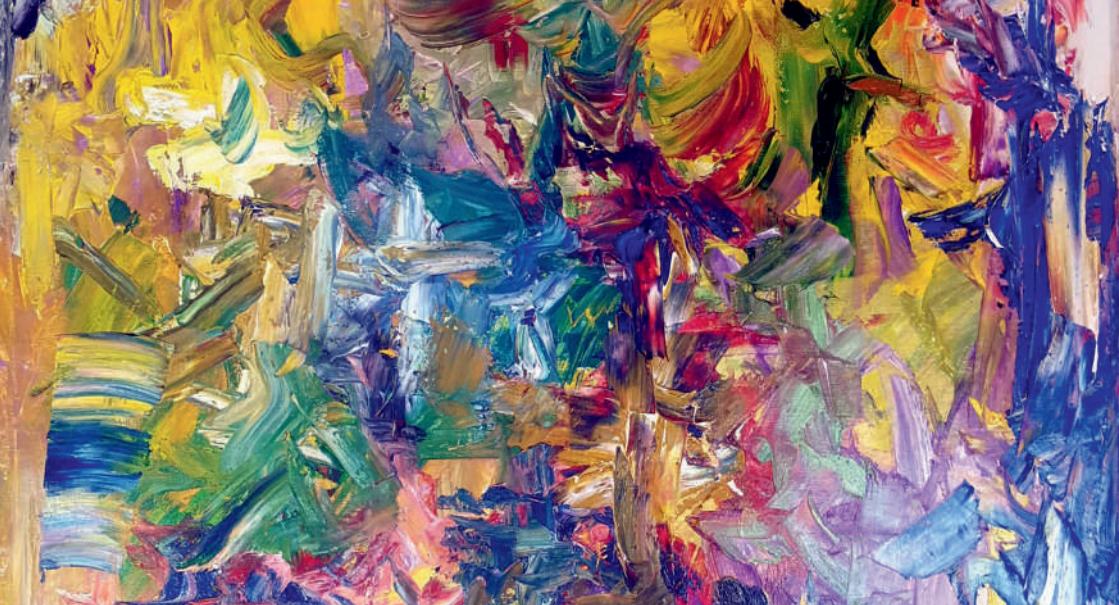

Is taispeántas aonair é “MURKTACKTISS” de shaothair an ealaíontóra Gerard Carson atá lonnaithe i mBéal Feirste. Cuimsíonn “MURKTACKTISS” píosaí dealbhóireachta, gearrthóga físe, beochaintí agus línióchtaí, agus díritear isteach ann ar mhodhanna léirithe/athruithe a bhfuil borradh ag teacht orthu i dtimpeallacht ina bhfuil líonraí eolais agus ábhair ag éirí níos teibí de réir a chéile. Is ionann MURKTACKTISS agus léiriú leanúnach ar an dóigh a gcónascann ábhair éagsúla lena chéile, agus baineann sé leas as an taighde atá déanta ag Carson ar líniócht Ghotach, ar oibriú ábhair agus ar áisiúlacht teicneolaíochta.

“MURKTACKTISS” is a solo exhibition of works by the Belfast-based artist Gerard Carson. Featuring sculptures, videos, animations, and drawings, MURKTACKTISS zones in on accelerated modes of production/extraction in an environment of increasingly abstracted networks of knowledge and materiality. Objects and materials become tangled in assemblages of extraction, suspended in arrays of metamorphosis, where individual units are swallowed into chaotic swarms of feedback. Novel formations emerge from this murky swamp of materiality, producing cybernetic hybrids that merge definitions of the ‘known/unknown’ and the ‘fictive/real’. MURKTACKTISS is an ongoing manifestation of material contingency, drawing upon Carson’s research into gothic flatlines, material agency, and technological utility.

Trasnáíonn imreacha a chéile, tarraingítear uigeachtaí, forluíonn dathanna ar a chéile agus measctar le chéile iad le cruthanna a dheardh a líonann an spás thart orthu. Ní bhíonn plean i bhfeidhm leis an saothar seo in am ar bith. Cruthaítear iad go spontáineach agus leatar na holaí ar an chanbhás le sceana pailéid agus le gnáthrudai randamacha ar tháinig an t-ealaíontóir orthu. Na cruthanna agus na dathanna a thagann dá bharr an phróisis seo, cuireann siad draíocht ar shamhláíocht an duine. Léiríonn an teibíocht atá sa nádúr acu, a d'fhéadfadh cuma trína chéile a chur orthu, spraoi ildaite atá fiú le feiceáil sna teidil atá orthu.

Abstracts, is a collection of works by the artist dmcq (1960, belfast). Themes of reflection and presence are explored as the paintings flow through a world of abstractness where colour and shape are abundant. Shades cross, textures drag while colours overlap and merge, creating forms, occupying the surrounding space. The works are never planned, they are in the moment and the oils are applied to the canvas with palette knives and found objects. The resulting shapes and colour illuminate and captivate the imagination. Their abstract and what may seem, chaotic nature, unveiling a colourful play stretching into their titles.

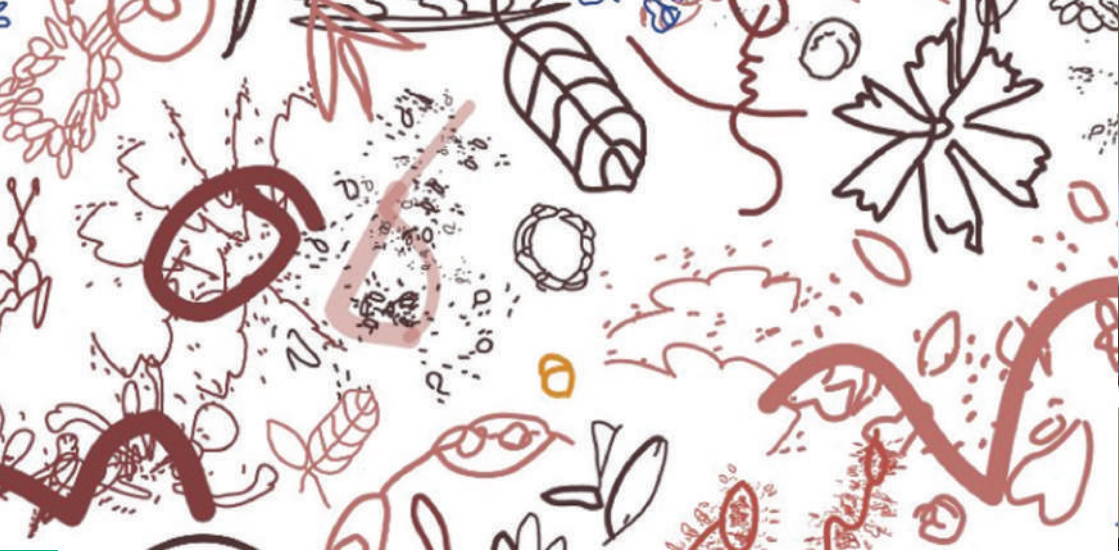

The 'Quantum' collection is a series of quirky stylistic patterns and placement prints for both fashion and interiors. The designs have a certain amount of humour to them and are impactful, modern and fun. How many different symbols/objects can you find and list in Irish? Or can you find any hidden letters in the patterns and make a word or sentence in Irish?
