Is deis dúinn é an corp agus an t-anam a athnuachan tar éis imeachtaí bríomhara an tsamhraidh agus fonn orainn toiseacht amach ar aistear nua, cé acu a rachaidh tú ag foghlaim na Gaeilge, ag cumadh filíochta nó ar an aistear ceoil a bheas mar chuid den chomhfhiontar iontach atá á reáchtáil againn in éineacht le Myra Zepf agus Ceolfoireann Uladh, 'Mo Cheol Thú!'

Mar is nós linn, beidh neart imeachtaí tarraigteacha ann do gach aoisgrúpa gus muid muiníneach go mbeidh sibh ábalta bhur n-aistear pearsanta, pléisiúrtha féin a dhéanamh linn.

Cé nach mbeidh muid faoi dhíon na Cultúrlainne féin i gcónaí, tá agus beidh muid le chéile i spiorad agus in anam.

ag toiseacht le seoladh taispeántas de na saothair ealaíne atá bailithe ag an Chultúrlann le 30 bliain anuas. Beidh scoth an tsaothair le feiceáil i nDánlann Dillon.

Tá Cultúrlann McAdam Ó Fiaich tionmanta i gcónaí do sheirbhísí ealaíon agus cultúir ar ardchaighdeán a chur ar fáil dár bpobal, idir óg agus aosta. Teachtaireacht ónár bpríomh-mhaoinitheoir

Tá rudaí suntasacha ag tarlú sna healaíona. Tá Cultúrlann McAdam Ó Fiaich ina cuid thábhachtach le fada an lá de líonrá na n-ionad a sholáthraíonn, le tacáiocht ón Chomhairle Ealaíon, raon iomlán gníomhaíochtaí cruthaitheacha agus léirithe ar fud an tuaiscirt. An tuiscint go mbaineann muid le líonra níos leithne, tagann sin go nádúrtha linn, agus tá an meon sin ag éirí níos ábhartha le cúpla mí anuas, áfach, agus an oiread sin ealaíne níos inrochtana ag an oiread sin daoine, de réir mar a d'iompaigh eagraíochtaí níos mó agus níos mó ar chláir ar líne. Ciallaíonn na meáin shóisialta gur féidir taitneamh a bhaint as na himeachtaí cruthaitheacha iontacha i gclár nua na Cultúrlainne, Is cuma cé acu i mBéal Feirste, i mBéal Átha Seanaidh nó sna hOileáin Bhailéaracha atá tú i do chónai. Táimid anois ag roinnt ár gcultúr agus ár gcruthaitheacht le lucht féachana níos leithne agus níos éagsúla ná mar a shamhlófaí riamh.

Ceann de na rudaí dearfacha a tháinig chun cinn le linn na paindéime uafásáí seo is ea freagairt na n-ealaíontóirí agus na n-eagraíochtaí ealaíon, a ghlac chucu féin réitigh dhigiteacha agus ar líne chun lucht féachana - sean agus nua - a mhealladh. Agus ní raibh

tóir an phobail ar na healaíona chomh soiléir riamh. Thug na healaíona misneach agus siamsaíocht dúinn le linn na dianghlásála; agus is íocshláinte iad in aimsir seo na srianta sóisialta leanúna-cha; agus tá deiseanna nua á n-oscailt acu.

Mar sin féin, ní féidir aon rud a chur in áit an ardphléisiúir a bhaineann le léirithe agus imeachtaí beo, fisiciúla, a mbaintear taitneamh astu i gcuideachta daoine eile - mar a tharla i gcónaí in áiteanna mar an Chultúrlann. 



Brussels, Sweden and at home here in
Ireland. In 2019 Ciara became the am-
bassador for the Irish Writers Centre.
Her poetry and literary essays have
been published in various journals
including Icarus and Comhar. She is
currently working on her first collection
of poems. Included in her commis-
sioned work are pieces for RTÉ TV,
BBC Radio, TG4 and The Irish Writers
Centre.

Ifor ap Glyn

Is craoltóir agus file aitheanta é Ifor ap Glyn a bhfuil go leor duaisíanna buaite aige. Rugadh é i Londain do thuismitheoirí Breatnacha ach tá cónaí air anois i gCaernarfon. Ceapadh mar Fhile Náisiúnta na Breataine Bige é in 2016, gradam a bhrónann ‘Literature Wales’, agus is é Ifor an ceathrú file leis an ghradam sin a bhaint amach. Is é a ról é bheith ag freagairt d’imeachtaí a bhfuil tábhacht náisiúnta ag baint leo agus bheith ar an ardán ag imeachtaí agus féilte fud fad an domhain ag ardú feasachta ar scríbhneoireacht agus ar scríbhneoirí na Breataine Bige. Tá Corón na filíochta buaite aige faoi dhó ag an Eisteddfod Náisiúnta.

Mae Ifor ap Glyn yn fardd a darlleddwr arobryn. Cafodd ei eni yn Llundain i reini Cymraeg ond mae bellach yn byw yng Nghaernarfon. Cafodd ei enwi yn bedwerydd Bardd Cenedlaethol Cymru yn 2016. Rheolir cynllun Bardd Cenedlaethol Cymru gan Llenyddiaeth Cymru. Disgwyllir iddo ymateb i ddigwyddiadau o bwys cenedlaethol ac ymddangos mewn digwyddiadau a gwyliau yng Nghymru a thu hwnt i godi proffil awduron ac ysgrifennu o Gymru. Mae e wedi enill Coron yr Eisteddfod Genedlaethol ddwywaith.



Ifor ap Glyn is an award-winning broadcaster and poet. He was born in London to Welsh parents but now lives in Caernarfon. He became the 4th National Poet of Wales in 2016. The National Poet of Wales initiative is delivered by Literature Wales. His role is to respond to events of national significance and to appear at events and festivals worldwide to raise the profile of writing and writers from Wales. He has twice won the Crown for poetry at the National Eisteddfod.

Pàdraig MacAoidh

Is as Oileán Leòdhais sna hInse Ghall Amuigh do Phàdraig MacAoidh. D'fhoilsigh Acair a chéad duanaire filíochta Gu Leòr/Galore sa bhliain 2015 agus gearrliostaíodh é don duais Donald Meek agus don Saltire Scottish Poetry Book of the Year. Foilsíodh a dhara bailiúchán, Nàdur De ar na mallaibh. Foilsíodh a shaothar go forleathan in irisleabhair, irisí agus ar líne agus ar an raidió agus aistríodh go Gearmáinis, Fraincis, Gaeilge, Seicis, Slóvaicis agus Béarla é. Oibríonn sé mar léachtóir ag Ollscoil Chill Rìmhinn (tar éis sealanna a chaitheamh ag obair in ionad Filíochta Seamus Heaney, Ollscoil na Tríonóide i mBaile Átha Cliath, agus mar iriseoir craolacháin agus léiritheoir don BBC). Tá cónai air i nDùn Éideann

"S ann à Eilean Leòdhais anns na h-Eileanan Siar a tha Pàdraig MacAoidh. Chaidh Gu Leòr, a chiad chruinneachadh leis, fhoillseachadh le Acair ann an 2015; bha sin air gearrliosta na Duaise Saltire airson Leabhar Bàrdachd na Blìadhna. Tha dàrna leabhar leis, Nàdur De, air ùr-nochdach am bliadhna-sa. Tha a chuid bàrdachd air nochdadh fad 's farsaing ann an irisean 's paipearan-naidheachd agus air an rèdio, agus chaidh a thionndadh gu Gearmailteach, Frangais, Gaeilge, Seicis, Slòbhacais agus Beurla. Tha e ag obair mar oraid-



aiche aig Oilthigh Chill Rìmhinn (an dèidh bliadhnaichean ag obair anns an Seamus Heaney Centre for Poetry, Colaisde na Trionaid ann am Baile Átha Cliath, agus airson a' BhBC mar fhear-naidheachd agus riochdaire).

Peter Mackay is from the Isle of Lewis in the Outer Hebrides. His first collection of poems, Galore, was published by Acair in 2015 and was on the shortlist for the Saltire and Donald Meek Prizes; his second collection, Some Kind Of, has just been published. His work has been widely published in journals, magazines and online and on the radio, and translated into German, French, Irish, Czech, Slovakian and English. He works as a lecturer at the University of St Andrews (after spells working at the Seamus Heaney Centre for Poetry, Trinity College Dublin and as a broadcast journalist and producer for the BBC).






