# Teachtaireacht ón choiste eagrúcháin

## *Message from organising committee*

Agus deireadh 2020 ag druidim linn, tá muid ag tarraingt ar dheireadh bliain chorrathach éagsúil agus is cinnte go bhfuil siamsaíocht agus cúis cheiliúrtha de dhíth orainn anois níos mó ná a bhí roimhe! Tháinig eagraíochtaí laistigh den Cheathrú Ghaeltachta le chéile le clár imeachtaí draíochta a chur ar fáil don phobal ó chian agus ó chongar. Tá éagsúlacht imeachtaí curtha le chéile againn lena n-áirítear lasadh shoilse na Nollag, mar a bhíonn ann gach bliain; amharclannaíocht na Nollag do na páistí (agus gach seans go mbeidh an fear mór sa chulaith dhearg ann fosta!), a bhúí le Brassneck Theatre agus plúr an cheoil sa Chultúrlann agus in Áras Uí Chonghaile. Is fleadh faoi leith í Fleadh Feirste a léiríonn bunluachanna phobal na Gaeilge in iarthar na cathrach lena n-áirítear an chomhpháirtíocht, an chomhbhá agus an chomhghuaillíocht. Tá lúcháir orainn

gur tháinig grúpaí éagsúla le chéile leis an chlár ildánach, ilchineálach a chur faoi bhur mbráid. Is de thoradh an chomhoibríthe sin a d'éirigh linn clár imeachtaí fíorúil a chur le chéile a thugann léargas ar phobal fuinniúil, flúirseach, Gaelach na Ceathrún Gaeltachta agus na gceantar máguaird.

Beidh rogha na litríochta againn a bhúí leis An tSnáthaid Mhór agus Máire Zepf agus beidh agallamh á chur ag Eoghan Ó Néill ar Phádraig Ó Mianáin, príomheagarthóir an Concise English-Irish Dictionary. Cuirfear na healaíona chun tosaigh agus léiriú úr ag Aisling Ghéar agus taispeántas ealaíne leis an Drawing Journal. Is léiriú í Fleadh Feirste ar dhíograis an phobail ildánaigh chruthaithigh atá thart orainn agus tá an pobal sin faoi anáil agus faoi chomaoin mhór i gcónaí ag na ceannródaithe a tháinig romhainn, a bhunaigh Gaeltacht Bhóthar Seoighe, Meánscoil Feirste, Cultúrlann McAdam Ó Fiaich agus níos mó; na daoine a spreag agus a spreagann go fóill sinn agus beidh sé seo le sonrú sna himeachtaí caomhnaithe oidhreachtacha atá sa chlár ar nós sheoladh 'Claochlú Cultúir agus an Conradh' de chuid Chonradh na

Gaeilge agus 'An Scéal go dtí Seo' le hÁras Uí Chonghaile a insíonn scéal Uí Chonghaile agus an lorg buan a d'fhág sé. Tá an Chultúrlann féin ag tarraingt ar bhliain mhór cheiliúrtha agus is cuí go mbeidh imeacht againn a cheiliúrann oidhreacht na Cultúrlainne, 'Dá mBeadh Caint ag na Ballaí', agus muid 30 bliain ar an fhód.

Cé nach mbeidh muid ábalta bheith in éineacht a chéile mar a bheadh muid de ghnáth, bígí cinnte go mbeidh muid le chéile i spiorad agus an Cheathrú Ghaeltachta faoi sholas is faoi spiorad na Nollag le linn na Fleidhe le scoth na hamharclannaíochta, ceoil, plé, scéalaíochta agus ceardaíochta do pháistí agus aosaigh ar aon. Nollaig faoi shonas agus faoi shéan oraibh, a chairde!

As 2020 draws to a close, it has been a very different and at times challenging year creating a need for entertainment and celebration now more than ever! Groups within the Gaeltacht Quarter came together to respond to that need and provide a magical programme of events for the community at home and abroad. We have created a range of activities including the annual switching on of

our Christmas lights, family theatre (where the big man in red may even make an appearance) with Brassneck and the best of traditional music in Cultúrlann and Áras Uí Chonghaile, Fleadh Feirste demonstrates the core values of the Irish language community in the west of the city: working together and common mission. 
## Taispeántas Ealaíne

### *Art Exhibition:*

### *The Drawing Journal*

Is comharghrúpa é an Drawing Journal de sheachtar ealaíontóirí a dhíríonn, trí chomhthograí, ar mhianach na líníochta. “Íomhá na Smaointeoireachta” is teideal don taispeántas a chuimsíonn saothar Tamzin Ashcroft, Niamh Clarke, Hannah Clegg, Daniel Coleman, Shauna McDonald, Sharon McKeown agus Doris Rohr. Tugann na healaíontóirí cuireadh don phobal

blas a fháil ar thoradh dhá bhliain de mhalartú líníochtaí agus téacs i gCultúrlann Mac Adam Ó Fiaich. Tá sé mar rún sa taispeántas seo díriú ar ábharthacht téacs agus líníochta agus ar an ghaolmhaireacht eatarthu chomh maith leis an iliomad éagsúlachtaí a bhaineann leo beirt a aistriú ó cheann go ceann. Déanann na naisc idir bhaill aonaracha agus comhthéacsanna cultúrtha níos leithne eolas don ghníomhaíocht fhísiúil a bhaineann le téacs a dhíthógáil sa líníocht: ‘íomhá na smaointeoireachta’. Déantar léamh eile ar íomhánna den chineál seo sa chur síos físiúil, sa chomhcheangal fileata agus i ról na bhfotheideal; agus ar an bhealach sin, déantar scaradh



na scríbhneoireachta ón líníocht a chomhchuiisiú sa mhalartú iomlán.

The Drawing Journal is a collective of seven artists who investigate the potential of drawing through collaborative projects. 'The Image of Thought' is the title of an exhibition featuring works by Tamzin Ashcroft, Niamh Clarke, Hannah Clegg, Daniel Coleman, Shauna McDonald, Sharon McKeown and Doris Rohr. The artists are inviting the public to share the outcomes of over two years of drawing and text based exchanges held at Cultúrlann McAdam Ó Fiaich. This exhibition seeks to investigate the materiality of and relationship between text and drawing, and the

possibility to translate one through the other in all multiplicities. The rhizomatic connections between individual members and wider cultural contexts inform this visual activity of deconstructing text through drawing: an 'image of thought'. Such images are re-interpreted through visual description, poetic association and the role of (sub) title captions; thereby the separation of writing from drawing becomes subsumed in the overall exchange.

Drawing, writing, what expeditions, what wanderings, and at the end, no end, we won't finish, rather time will put an end to it. (Helene Cixous *Stigmata* London: Routledge 1998)

## Claochlú Cultúir & an Conradh

Le dhá bhliain anuas, tá foireann Chonradh na Gaeilge ag obair ar thionscadal oidhreachta, ‘Claochlú Cultúir agus an Conradh’, atá maoinithe ag Ciste Oidhreachta an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta ó thuaidh agus a dhíríonn ar stair Chonradh na Gaeilge/Chomhaltas Uladh i gcúige Uladh. Mar chuid den tionscadal seo, tá cartlann dhigiteach tógtha acu ar shuíomh úr ina bhfuil cáipéisí ó gach cearn de chúige Uladh agus agallaimh le baill an Chonartha,

mar aon le neart cáipéisíocht stairiúil eile. Beidh an tionscadal á sheoladh go hoifigiúil mar chuid de Fhleadh Feirste. Beidh ceann de na hagallaimh staire a rinneadh á thaispeáint mar chuid den seoladh agus ansin, don chéad uair riamh, beidh deis ag an phobal súil a chaitheamh ar an suíomh úr.



For the past two years, the team at Conradh na Gaeilge have been working on a Heritage Lottery funded project, Claochlú Cultúir agus an Conradh, which investigates the history of Conradh na Gaeilge and Comhaltas Uladh in Ulster. As part of this project, there is a digital archive on a new website with documents from every corner in Ulster, interviews with League members along with plenty of other historic documents.

The project will be officially launched as part of Fleadh Feirste and one of our interviews will be shown at the launch of the new site!


