

## Tim Franco: Unperson North Korean Defectors Belfast Photo Festival

Sa leabhar ‘1984’, le George Orwell, is ionann ‘unperson’ agus duine a fuadaíodh, duine ar scriosadh gach tagairt a ndearnadh riamh dó. Ar an dóigh chéanna, na teifigh sin ón Chóiré Thuaidh, a léiríonn an grianghrafadóir Francach-Polannach Tim Franco, chinn siad imeacht leo, ag teitheadh in amanna ar chúiseanna idé-eolaíocha, agus go minic mar gheall ar an éadóchas.

Tá an bóthar go dtí an Chóiré Theas contúirteach agus féadann an turas blianta a thógáil, thar na teorainneacha éagsúla leis an Mhongóil, Laos, an Téalainn agus an tSín. Líontar taisteal na ndaoine a dhéanann é leis an eagla go ngabhfar iad agus go seolfar ar ais chuig campaí oibre iad. I ndiaidh dóibh an Chóiré Theas a bhaint amach, is minic a bhíonn sé deacair orthu féiniúlacht nua a aimsiú agus iad cailte idir an t-am a chaith siad sa Chóiré Thuaidh agus a dtodhchaí sa Chóiré Theas. Chun an t-aistriú dochreidte sin a léiriú, úsáideann an grianghrafadóir Tim Franco ábhar analógach nach bhfuil in ainm a bheith ann: claonchló polaroid a nochtar trí shraith

d’ionaithe ceimiceacha, próiseas a mbíonn toradh éiginnte neamhfhoirfe air go minic. D’fhonn conairí na dteifeach a aisghabháil, thaistil Franco go dtí na pointí trasnaithe inar éalaigh siad, agus é mar aidhm aige éagsúlacht an tírdhreacha atá mar chúlra ag an teifeach ón Chóiré Thuaidh a ghabháil.

Is grianghrafadóir Francach-Polannach é Tim Franco a rugadh i bPáras in 1982. In 2005, bhog sé go dtí an tSín áit ar thosaigh sé ag doiciméadú uirbiú dochreidte na tíre agus a thionchar sóisialta agus é ag comhoibriú le nuachtáin lena n-áirítear Le Monde, an Wall Street Journal agus an New York Times. In 2015, d’fhoilsigh sé a chéad Mhonaagraf – Metamopolis – toradh ar chúig bliana d’obair ar imircí tuaithe sa chathair is gasta a ndearnadh uirbiú uirthi ar domhan: Chongqing. In 2016 bhog Franco go dtí an Chóiré Theas áit ar thosaigh sé ag obair ar thogra fadtéarmach faoi theifigh ón Chóiré Thuaidh.

In George Orwell’s 1984, an unperson is someone who has been vaporized, whose record has been erased. Similarly, the North Korean defectors that Tim Franco portrays have decided to disappear, fleeing sometimes for ideological reasons and often out of despair.



The road to South Korea is dangerous and can take years, across the many different borders with Mongolia, Laos, Thailand and China. The travels of the people who do make it out are filled with the fear of being arrested and sent back to labour camps. Having arrived in South Korea, they often struggle to find a new identity; lost between their North Korean past and South Korean future. To reflect this incredible transition, in documenting North Korean defectors photographer Tim Franco uses an analogue material that is not supposed to exist: the negative of a polaroid revealed through a series of chemical purifications, resulting often in something uncertain and imperfect. In order to retrace the defector's trails, Franco travelled to the crossing points where they made their escape, aiming to capture the diversity of landscape

that is the background of North Korean defection.

Tim Franco is a French-Polish photographer born in Paris in 1982. In 2005, he moved to China where he started documenting the country's incredible urbanization and its social impact while collaborating with newspapers such as Le Monde, the Wall Street Journal and the New York Times. In 2015, he published his first Monograph - Metamorphosis - the conclusion of five years of work on the rural migrations in the fastest urbanizing city in the world: Chongqing. In 2016, Franco moved to South Korea where he started working on a long term project about North Korean defectors.

## Gan Srian Unconfined: Stephen Shaw

Bailiúchán tarraingteach de phictiúir uiscdhatha leis an ealaíontóir iomráiteach Stephen Shaw atá aitheanta as a dhírú ar áiteanna dearmadta i mBéal Feirste ar bhonn mionréalaíoch. Na píosaí seo, a críochnaíodh le dhá bhliain anuas, go leor acu le linn na dtréimhsí dianghlasála, tugann siad léargas fíorshuimiúil, greannmhar, dúshlánach uaireanta, ar chodanna de Bhéal Feirste, d'Éirinn agus d'áiteanna eile nach iad thar lear. Níor taispeánadh a bhformhór riamh.

Bhí Stephen ag obair ar chuid de na pictiúir seo roimh phaindéim an choróinvíris agus na tréimhsí dianghlasála. Cé go raibh sé sáinnithe sa bhaile, níor chuir sé sin isteach nó amach ar a chruthaitheacht ná ar a eitic oibre. De bharr an choisc ar thaisteal agus ar bhailiú smaointe nua dá réir, bhí deis ag Stephen amharc siar ar ábhar tagartha a bhailigh sé sna blianta a chuaigh thart, ábhar nach raibh an fhaill aige roimhe seo oibriú air mar gheall ar thograí agus coimitimintí eile.

Mar thoradh air sin tá bailiúchán fíorshuimiúil de shaothar úrnu curtha le chéile aige. Gan bhaic, gan téamaí, gan aon spriocdhátaí, gan srianta! Anois, radhairc ar chuir sé spéis iontu le gairid agus roimhe sin arís, tá siad tugtha chun beatha faoi dheireadh agus cuirtear i láthair iad sa taispeánas nua seo.

A fascinating collection of water colour paintings by renowned artist, Stephen Shaw, acclaimed for examining overlooked parts of Belfast in realistic fine detail. These pieces, completed within the last two years, many in Lockdowns, offer intriguing, humorous, sometimes challenging, glimpses of parts of Belfast, Ireland and abroad. Most have never been exhibited before.

Stephen had been working on some of these paintings before the Covid Pandemic and Lockdowns. Being confined to his home and studio did not stop the creativity or “work ethic”. Unable to travel and gather new ideas, he revisited reference material gathered in previous years, but not yet worked on because of other projects and commitments.

This has resulted in an intriguing body of brand new works. No boundaries, no themes, no limitations, no deadlines, unconfined! Scenes that interested him in recent times and the not so distant past are now finally, and happily, brought to life and presented in this new exhibition.

Le himeacht ama, tháinig sé chun cinn mar phearsa lárnach sa saol polaitiúil ó thuaidh, de réir mar a ghéaraigh na trioblóidí. D'imigh an Cairdinéal Ó Fiaich ar shlí na fírinne in 1990 agus

ainmníodh Cultúrlann McAdam Ó Fiaich, a osclaíodh in 1991, in ómós dó. Sa léacht seo, amharcfaidh an t-iriseoir John Cooney ar an spéis mhór a bhí ag an Chairdinéal sa teanga agus ar a thionchar ar chúrsaí polaitíochta anseo sa Tuaisceart.

### Maidir le John Cooney

De réir an Ollaimh Terence Brown ina stair oifigiúil The Irish Times, 150 Years of Influence, tá John Cooney ““chun tosaigh maidir le hábhar plé agus conspóide bríomhar a dhéanamh den reiligiún.” Ó tháinig sé go hÉirinn ó Albain in 1972, tá go leor scríofa aige ar “Na Trioblóidí” d’fhoilseacháin anseo in Éirinn agus sa Bhreatain lena n-áirítear The Glasgow Herald agus The Times. Tá sé ar an aon



iriseoir amháin in Éirinn le bheith ina chomhfhreagraí creidimh don Irish Times agus don Irish Independent ar aon. Faoi anáil idéil Réabhlóid na Fraince, ba bhunaitheoir-stiúrthóir é ar Scoil Samhraidh Humbert i gCo Mhaigh Eo idir 1987 – 2014 agus faoi láthair tá sé ag tabhairt faoi Chumann Hans Kung na hÉireann a bhunú i gcomhar le Brendan Butler. Is scríbhneoir rialta leis an léirmheas dhiaga, Doctrine & Life é agus ba Chomhalta Cuartaíochta Oinigh é sa Léann Éireannach idir 1996-1998 ag Ollscoil Obar Dheathain. Is é a scríobh John Charles McQuaid, Ruler of Catholic Ireland agus tá sé ag ullmhú na beathaisnéise Cardinal Tomás Ó Fiaich, Ireland's Lost Peacemaker.

Tomás Ó Fiaich was born in Cullyhanna in south Co. Armagh. A noted scholar in the Irish language and with a profound interest in folk lore and history. He became a Cardinal in 1979 and continued to follow his deep interest in Irish and local history, becoming a key figure also in the political life in the North as the 'Troubles' continued to unfold. Cardinal Ó Fiaich died in 1990 and Cultúrlann, which opened in 1991, was named in his memory. In this lecture, journalist John Cooney will look at the Cardinal's keen interest in language and his impact on political affairs here in the north.



## About John Cooney

John Cooney is described by Professor Terence Brown in his official history of The Irish Times, 150 Years of Influence, as being “to the fore in making religion a subject of vigorous discussion and controversy.” Since coming to Ireland from Scotland in 1972 he has written extensively on “The Troubles” for Irish and British publications including The Glasgow Herald and The Times. He is the only journalist in Ireland to have been religion correspondent for both the Irish Times and the Irish Independent. Inspired by the ideals of the French Revolution, he was founder-director of the Humbert Summer School in Co. Mayo from 1987-2014, and currently is forming the Hans Küng Society of Ireland with

Brendan Butler. A frequent contributor to the theological review, Doctrine & Life, he was Honorary Visiting Fellow in Irish Studies from 1996-1998 at the University of Aberdeen. The author of John Charles McQuaid, Ruler of Catholic Ireland, he is preparing a biography of Cardinal Tomás Ó Fiaich, Ireland’s Lost Peacemaker.


