Word from the Director

Maidir le Kerri Ní Dhochartaigh

Is meascán de bheathaisnéis, stair agus scribhinní dúlra é 'Thin Places' le Kerri Ní Dhochartaigh. Díríonn sí ar an dóigh ar choinnigh an dúlra stuama í agus í ag fás aníos i nDoire, áit ar díbriodh a teaghlaach as a dteach faoi dhó agus ar caitheadh buama peitril isteach ar fhuinneog a seomra leapa. Scríobhann sí faoin teorainn idir an bhochtaineacht agus an saibhreas, an foréigean agus an suaimhneas agus an bealach a chasann an dúlra orainn leath bealaigh. "Is píosa scribhneoireachta ar leith é," dar le Robert MacFarlane. Tá cónaí ar Kerri Ní Dhochartaigh in Éirinn.

Kerri Ní Dochartaigh's *Thin Places* is a blend of memoir, history and nature writing. It's about how nature kept her sane when she was growing up in Derry where her family was forced out of its home twice, and a petrol bomb was thrown through her bedroom window. She writes about the borders of poverty and wealth, violence and tranquillity, and how nature meets us halfway. *Thin Places* was called "a remarkable piece of writing" by Robert MacFarlane.

Kerri Ní Dhochartaigh lives in Ireland.



Maidir le Cal Flyn

Is leabhar é 'Islands of Abandonment: Life in the Post-Human Landscape' le Cal Flyn faoi áiteanna tréigthe - idir bhailte tréigthe agus zón eisiamh agus an rud a tharlaíonn nuair a ligtear don dúlra filleadh ar a thimpeallacht nádúrtha. Scríobhann Flyn faoi réimse áiteanna idir thithe ionradaithe Shearnóbail, na sráideanna tréigthe iarthionsclaíoch in Detroit agus réigiúin mhiandóireachta na hAlban. Is leabhar é a dhíríonn ar thionchar daonna ar an dúlra agus cad é a tharlaíonn i ndiaidh dúinn imeacht ar shlí na firinne. Rinne The Times cur síos ar 'Islands of Abandonment' mar leabhar, "an-spéisiúil ar spreagadh intinne é." Tá cónaí ar Cal Flyn in Inse Orc.

Cal Flyn's 'Islands of Abandonment: Life in the Post-Human Landscape' is a book about abandoned places - from ghost towns to exclusion zones - and what happens when nature is allowed to reclaim its place. Flyn writes about places as varied as Chernobyl's irradiated homes, the derelict post-industrial streets of Detroit, and Scotland's mining regions. It's a book that asks about the human impact on nature and what happens after we're gone. Islands of Abandonment was called "fascinating and brain-energising" by The Times. Cal Flyn lives on Orkney.
