The Cultúrlann building has been standing proud and tall for 125 years, and an important part of our work is to ensure it will remain an invaluable resource for the community for many years to come. people everywhere. Our visual arts programme celebrates our commitment to both exploring our heritage and helping future generations fulfil their potential. The work of world-renowned Belfast artist Dan O'Neill (1920-1974) will be exhibited in June, while last year's recipient of the Cultúrlann McAdam Ó Fiaich Graduate Student Award, Euen Gébler, will have his first solo show in May. There's plenty more to see inside, and we look forward to welcoming you to An Chultúrlann soon!

Cuireadh túis le Tionscnamh Leabhar Noor Ash Shams in 2014 agus é mar aidhm leis leabhair do pháistí in Araibis agus i nGaeilge a fhoilsiú agus a dháileadh ar léitheoirí óga in Éirinn agus sa Phalaistín le go mbeadh tuiscint acu ar chultúr a chéile.

A beautiful book for children which encompasses seven stories from Palestine translated from Arabic to Irish. Scéalta ón bPalaistín sean agus nua (Stories from Palestine old and new) is the title of the book produced by the Noor Ash Shams Project, a collaborative project between Dublin City University and Birzeit University on the West Bank.

The Noor Ash Shams Book project was established in 2014 with the aim of publishing children's books in Arabic and in Irish and distributing them among young readers in Ireland and Palestine in order to promote a better understanding of one another's culture.





Geoffrey Keating/Seathrún Céitinn (c. 1569–c. 1644) author of *Foras Feasa ar Éirinn*, a history of Ireland from earliest times to the twelfth century offered a devastating indictment of previous historians who had both consistently and consciously ignored the achievements of the native Irish. “The bone and marrow of history,” he assured skeptical readers, was to be found in poems, in the poetic tradition of the Irish language. Across the turbulent and often traumatic centuries, such poets witnessed and gave witness to a multiplicity of Irish experiences; the rich and multifaceted tradition they created is both a reckoning with Irish, European, and

global realities, and an imaginative response to them. This bilingual anthology casts a wide net, and traces Irish history since the sixth century to the present day, with the aid of introductory essays and headnotes by a team of twenty-four renowned international scholars, it makes evident that so much of the bone and marrow of Irish history and culture is poetry.



Like art and instincts, illnesses are undeniably a part of human life and have always been with us from the beginning of time. Illness and decline are normal, yet we feel and act abnormal. The reality of situations feels dreamlike and surreal, which is something she hopes to capture within her imagery. She loves the idea of looking at a piece as it reminds us either of something within, something outside of your body or even outside of your being altogether.

## Daniel O'Neill

Rugadh Daniel O'Neill (1920 - 1974), nó Dan mar is fearr aithne air i measc a chairde, an 21 Eanáir 1920 i Sráid Dimsdale in larthar Bhéal Feirste. Féinmhúinte don chuid is mó, theagasc an péintéir Sidney Smith é ina stiúideo i Sráid Howard, áit ar ceadaíodh dó scuaba agus ábhair eile a úsáid. Sa bhliain 1945, ofráladh conradh dánlainne dó le Victor Waddington, a bhainistigh an dánlann ba mhó le rá i mBaile Átha Cliath ag an am a chuir spéis ar leith san ealaín chom-

haimseartha. Sna blianta i ndiaidh an chogaidh, thaistil sé go Páras agus bhí sé páirteach i ngrúpsheónna sa bhaile agus thar lear lena chairde Geard Dillon, George Campbell, Colin Middleton agus Nevill Johnson. In 1952, moladh go mór sa bhaile agus go hidirnáisiúnta é as an taispeántas iardhearcach a d'eagraigh CEMA in larsmalann agus Gailearaí Ealaíne Bhéal Feirste. Tar éis tréimhse a chaitheamh i Londain sna 1960í, d'fhill sé ar Bhéal Feirste agus d'fhan sé ann go dtí a bhás in 1974.



Daniel O'Neill (1920-1974) or 'Dan' as he was known to his friends, was born on 21st January 1920 in Dimsdale Street in West Belfast. Mostly self-taught, he was tutored by the painter Sidney Smith at his studio in Howard Street where he was allowed the use of brushes and materials. In 1945 he was offered a gallery contract with Victor Waddington who at that time ran the leading gallery in Dublin specializing in contemporary art. In the post-war years, he traveled to Paris and exhibited in group shows at home and

abroad with friends, Gerard Dillon, George Campbell, Colin Middleton and Nevill Johnson. A retrospective exhibition at the Belfast Museum and Art Gallery in 1952, organized by CEMA led to critical acclaim at home and on the international stage. After a period in London in the 1960s, he returned to Belfast where he remained until his death in 1974.
