Word from the Director

Ritheann féith na cruthaitheachta go tréan sa phobal agus an séasúr seo beidh ardán i gCultúrlann McAdam Ó Fiaich ag ealaíontóirí as gach cearn den tír agus níos faide i gcéin, ina measc Manchán Magan lena dhráma ‘Arán agus Im’ agus Johnny Óg Connolly, boscadóir agus cumadóir den chéad scoth as Indreabhán. Beidh taispeántas againn le daltaí Choláiste Feirste agus muid ag cuimhneamh go mór i mbliana ar an iarmhúinteoir ealaíne Nóirín Uí Chléirigh a cailleadh i mí an Mhárta. Tá taispeántas tochtmhar ciosamhairc le Sinéad O’Neill-Nicholl i nDánlann Dillon agus teistiméireachtaí ann le teaghligh na ndaoine a maraíodh sa bhuanáil i dteach tábhairne McGurk in 1971. Tá íomhánna suntasacha, láidre cruthaithe ag Róisín Ní Neachtain ina taispeántas siúd sna Ballaí Bána. Tá clú ar Naoise Ó Cairealláin mar Mhógláí Bap sa ghrúpa Kneecap. Beidh a sheó aonair faoi chearrbhachas gan srian, Minimal Human Contact, ar siúl sé oíche mar chuid de Fhéile Idirnáisiúnta



Ealaíon Bhéal Feirste, agus beidh an Júcbhosca Filíochta ar ais fosta le dánta i dtrí theanga. Seolfar leabhar úr i sraith Mhuireann le Malachy Doyle, maisithe ag Andrew Whitson, ag tús na scoilbhliana nua agus is mór an phrhléid dúinn gur anseo a bheidh Féile Leabhar Breac, foilsitheoirí as Conamara. San aimsir seo, agus brú ar dhaoine mar gheall ar chúinsí nach bhfuil mórán smachta againn orthu, tá súil againn go mbeidh tógáil croí le baint ag gach duine as Clár na Samhna i gCultúrlann McAdam Ó Fiaich agus go n-aimseoidh sibh áit theolaí anseo le cairdeas agus cuideachta a dhéanamh i rith an fhómhair.

Creativity runs deep in the community and we are delighted to welcome Manchán Magan with his drama 'Arán agus Im' as well as accomplished box player and composer, Johnny Óg Connolly from Indreabhán for very special performances of original work. The pupils of Coláiste Feirste will hold an exhibition in October as we fondly remember former art teacher Nóirín Uí Chléirigh who sadly passed away in March. Sinéad O'Neill-Nicholl has created an emotional audio-visual installation in the Dillon Gallery with testimonies from families who lost loved ones in the McGurk Bar bombing in 1971. Róisín Ní Neachtain's strong and stunning images will don the walls of Na Ballaí Bána until the start of October. Naoise Ó Cairealláin, who performs under the pseudonym Mógláí Bap with Kneecap, has a new one-man show, 'Minimal Human Contact', that takes on an intense journey through

the world of compulsive gambling.

The show has a six night run as part of the Belfast International Arts Festival, which also sees the return of the Poetry Jukebox, this time with poems in three languages.

An tSnáthaid Mhór have planned a wonderful launch event for Malachy Doyle's latest Muireann book, illustrated by Andrew Whitson, and we're thrilled that Connemara publisher Leabhar Breac will be holding Féile Leabhar Breac here in the Cultúrlann.

Times aren't easy, and there are issues effecting us that we can't control. We hope that our Samhain programme will lift your mind and heart and that you'll find Cultúrlann McAdam Ó Fiaich to be a warm, welcoming place this autumn.

Is ollamh emeritus le stair na hÉireann é Sean atá ag obair mar chomhalta taighde ar cuairt in Institiúid an Léinn Éireannaigh in Ollscoil na Banríona. Athbhreithniú fairsing ar dhiaspóra na hÉireann atá sa leabhar is deireanaí uaidh, *On Every Tide: The Making and the Remaking of the Irish World*, a dhéanann scrúdú ar na tionchair a chuir iallach ar na milliúin Éireannach, idir fhir agus mhná, a dtír dhúchais a thréigean, agus ar an saol a d'fhorbair siad dóibh féin ina mbaile nua, sios go dtí an fichiú haois nuair a d'iompaigh Éire féin ina tír a ghlac le himircigh seachas iad a onnmhairiú.



Sean is professor emeritus of Irish History and visiting research fellow at the Institute of Irish Studies at Queen's University. His latest book, *On Every Tide: The Making and the Remaking of the Irish World*, is a wide-ranging reassessment of the Irish diaspora which examines the forces that compelled millions of Irish men and women to abandon their homeland, the lives they built in their new homes, through to the twentieth century, when Ireland itself has become a receiver rather than an exporter of emigrants.

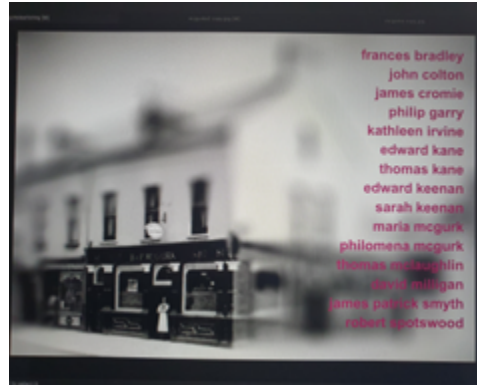

I gcaitheamh 2021, cuimhneachán caoga bliain bhuamáil Theach Tábhairne McGurk, thaifead Sinéad O'Neill-Nicholl comhráite le daoine muinteartha na ndaoine a fuair bás sa bhuamáil. Le teicnící iarléiriúcháin agus bogearraí eagarthóireacht fuaime, amharcann an t-ealaíontóir go grinn ar na struchtúir chumhachta a chruthaítear trí theanga i gcomhthéacs na firinne, an eolais agus an cheartais agus suim bhreise aici sna modhanna a úsáidtear le guth 'an duine eile' a chur ina thost.

'Ní bheidh sé mar a bhí' consists of an audio installation of reconstructed recorded interviews with some of the



relatives of those killed in the McGurk's Bar bombing of 1971. The installation offers a public space for those who lost their relatives to share their personal memories of grief and loss and to recall the events in their own words outside of the political and media spotlight.

Over the course of 2021, the fiftieth anniversary year of the McGurk's Bar bombing, Sinéad O'Neill-Nicholl recorded conversations with the relatives of those who were killed in the bombing. Through post-production techniques and audio editing software the artist examines the power structures created through language in the context of truth, knowledge and justice and is further interested in the methods used to silence the voice of the 'other'.

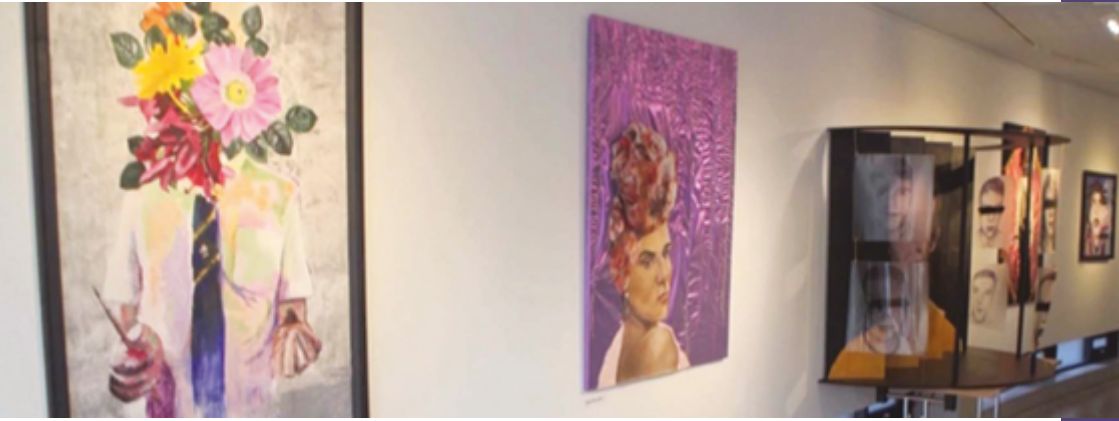

Is mó an lúcháir atá orainn i mbliana, go háirithe, ceiliúradh a dhéanamh ar chumas ealaíne ar leith an phobail áitiúil agus muid ag

comóradh 30 bliain den Chultúrlann, áit ar bunaíodh Meánscoil Feirste. It is a privilege for us every year to invite young, dedicated artists from Coláiste Feirste to showcase their artwork in Cultúrlann McAdam Ó Fiaich. This exhibition gives us an insight into the young people in our community and the subjects that inspire them to create their art. This exhibition is now a yearly event which showcases the immense talent coming out of the Coláiste Feirste art room. The pieces will include work by A-Level and GCSE students across a range of mediums. “Brexit Sausage” Shiro MASUYAMA

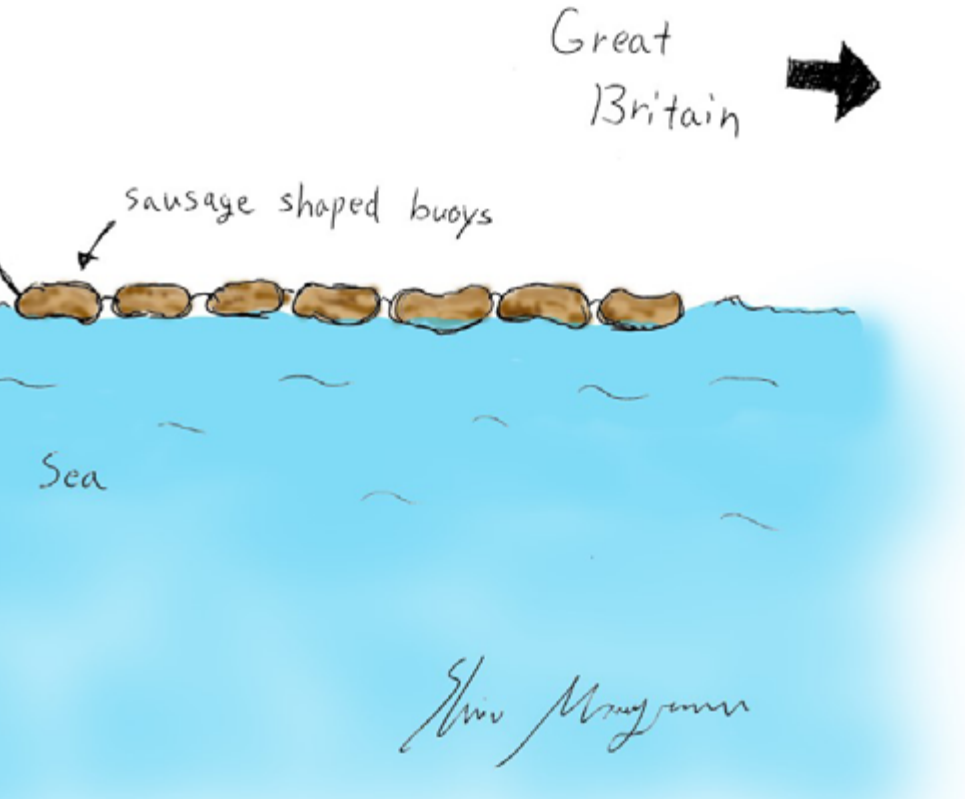
Tar éis Brexit, comhaontaíodh, faoi Phrótacal Thuaisceart Éireann, go leanfadh Tuaisceart Éireann rialacha an AE maidir le caighdeáin táirgí le seiceálacha feadh na teorann a chosc. Ina áit sin, dhéanfaí seiceálacha ar earraí a thíocfadh isteach i dTuaisceart Éireann ón Bhreatain Mhór ag calafoirt Thuaisceart Éireann. Spreag sé seo an gearán go bhfuil teorainn nua cruthaithe i Muir Éireann. Faoi rialacha sábháilteachta bia an AE, ní cheadaítear ispíní a thabhairt isteach i dTuaisceart Éireann ón Bhreatain Mhór níos mó. Tá an t-ealaíontóir Seapánach, Shiro Masuyama, atá lonnaithe i mBéal Feirste, tar éis idirghníomhaíocht shóisialta nua a dhearadh ag baint úsáide as ispíní le haird a dhíriú ar Theorainn seo Mhuir Éireann a cruthaíodh tar éis Brexit.

Rugadh Shiro Masuyama dTóiceo. Tar éis tréimhsí cónaitheachta idirnáisiúnta in Áras Nua-Ealaíne na hÉireann agus Stiúideoanna Flax Art, bhog Masuyama go Béal Feirste, áit a bhfuil sé lonnaithe ó shin i leith. Mar ealaíontóir Seapánach atá tar éis cur faoi i mBéal Feirste, tá sé san áit



ar leith sin ina dtig leis a cheistiú an dóigh ar féidir leis na fórsaí polaitiúla ceannasacha atá thart orainn tionchar a imirt ar an fhéiniúlacht.

After Brexit, under the Northern Ireland Protocol it was agreed that Northern Ireland would continue to follow EU rules on product standards to prevent checks along the border. Instead, inspections on goods entering Northern Ireland from Great Britain would take place at Northern Irish



ports. This has prompted criticism that a new border has been created in the Irish Sea. Under EU food safety rules, sausages are no longer allowed to enter Northern Ireland from Great Britain. Belfast-based, Japanese artist Shiro Masuyama has realized a new social intervention using sausages to highlight this Irish Sea Border which was created after Brexit.

Shiro Masuyama was born in Tokyo. Following international residencies in the Irish Museum of Modern Art and Flax Art Studios, Masuyama moved to Belfast, where he's been based ever since. As a Japanese artist who has settled in Belfast, he's in a unique position to question how identity can be influenced by the dominant political forces surrounding us.

Estranged

Eoscraíonn na téamaí a scrúdaítear i saothar Cleary as cultúr frithbhanda atá fite fuaite i sochaí na hÉireann le blianta fada anuas.

Is éard atá in *Estranged* ná suiteán mór suíomhoiriúnaithe déanta as réada tí díthógtha, atá péinteáilte bándearg agus carntha ar bharr a chéile i sraitheanna plúchtacha. Is freagairt é an saothar seo ar sháinniú ban sa teach.

An cnuasach sraitheach seo d'earraí tí atá leacaithe agus athchóirithe, tá sé crochta ar bhallaí na dánlainne mar chineál bacainne a fheidhmíonn mar léiriú follasach ar an bhacainn dhofheicthe sin a fhulaingíonn daoine a ndéantar mí-úsáid orthu. Tarlaíonn mí-úsáid teaghligh i suíomh fisiciúil agus imríonn sé tionchar mór ar an tsicé. Is freagairt fhollasach í *Estranged* air seo. Éiríonn an corp agus an aigne coimhthithe - freagairt anaithnid ar an mhí-úsáid. Is ann do dhá spás ag an am chéanna - spás taobh istigh de spás; is ionann sin agus an dánlann féin agus an Spás *Estranged* feadh a himill.

Themes explored in Cleary's work arise from a misogynistic culture that has been ingrained in Irish society for decades.

Estranged is large site-specific installation made from deconstructed domestic objects that are painted pink and are then stacked vertically in suffocating layers. The concept behind the work arises as a reaction to female entrapment in the home.



This layered assemblage of flattened and repurposed domestic fixtures lines the gallery walls acting as a type of obstacle that serves as a tangible representation of that invisible barrier experienced by those within the realm of abuse. Domestic abuse occurs within a physical arena with far reaching implications within the psychological.

Estranged is a tangible response to this. Body & mind become estranged, a disembodied reaction to abuse. Two spaces exist simultaneously, a space within a space; that of the gallery itself and the *Estranged* Space that lines its perimeter.

Arán & Im is a theatrical performance in which Manchán Magan bakes sourdough bread for 70 minutes while offering insights into the wonders of the Irish language – exploring potent words of landscape, terms of intuition and insight, and the many phrases that bring to life the mysterious glory of our natural world.

The show is a celebration of language, land and local Irish food, with freshly-baked traditional sourdough bread for the audience to slice and spread with butter they churn themselves from Irish cream. (Knowledge of Irish is not required.)

Arán & Im had a nationwide tour with the Abbey Theatre in 2018. In Autumn 2019 it toured widely again. In Spring

2022 it toured 16 cities, 13 states and 2 provinces in USA and Canada. It will tour the west coast of North America in 2023.
