Beidh ceol iomráiteach Andy Irvine le cloisteáil i Muileann Mhic Con Midhe a bhui le hÁras Uí Chonghaile agus cuirfidh Conradh na Gaeilge imeacht galánta ceolmhar i láthair a amharcfaidh ar an nasc atá idir ár logainmneacha agus an ceol dúchasach. Reáchtálfaidh Ionad Uíbh Eachach ollchiorcal comhrá i gCumann Chluain Árd a thabharfadh deis do Ghaeilgeoirí a bhfuil gach leibhéal líofachta acu teacht le chéile. Beidh lainseáil den togra ceannródaíoch, ‘Sólás na nÓg’ ag Glór na Móna agus i nDánlann Dillon agus sna Ballaí Bána, seolfar taispeántais speisialta le Shiro Masuyama agus Lorraine Cleary. Direofar spotsolas ar na scríbhneoirí

fosta nó seolfaidh An Ceathrú Póilí ‘Tearmann na Mara’, úrscéal nua le Jake Mac Siacais, agus eagrán úrnua den leabhar bheag Is clúití i measc na nGael, ‘Abair Amhrán’, a cuireadh le chéile ag Comhaltas Uladh den chéad uair go luath sna seascaidí. ## **Dúchas sa Cheol: The Place-Names of Ulster**

Participants will get an insight into the origin of our local place-names, and will hear how they feature in much of our local, traditional music.

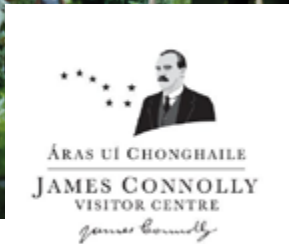

Is duine de mhórchheoltóirí na hÉireann é Andy Irvine, agus glór aige a léiríonn fíorchroí na hÉireann. Go deimhin, baisteadh “traidisiún ann féin” air. Agus é ina cheoltóir, amhránaí agus ina chumadóir amhrán, chaomhnaigh Andy a scileanna ceoil ar leith féin ar feadh gairmré de bhreis agus 50 bliain. Bhí Andy chun tosaigh ar bhuíonta ceoil lena n-áirítear Sweeney’s Men i lár na 60idí, an grúpa ardiomrá, ard-ratha Planxty sna 70idí, agus ansin Patrick Street, Mosaik, LAPD agus Usher’s Island ar na mallaibh. Is ceannródaí ceoil é Andy agus is mórphearsa é ó thaobh an cheoil agus ceoltóirí traidisiúnta de.

Andy Irvine is one of the great Irish singers, his voice one of a handful of truly great ones that gets to the very soul of Ireland. He has been hailed as “a tradition in himself”. Musician, singer, songwriter, Andy has maintained his highly individual performing skills throughout his over 50-year career. Andy has been at the helm of legendary bands like Sweeney’s Men in the mid 60s, to the enormous success of Planxty in the 70s, and then Patrick Street, Mozaik, LAPD and recently Usher’s Island. Andy has been a world music pioneer and an icon for traditional music and musicians.

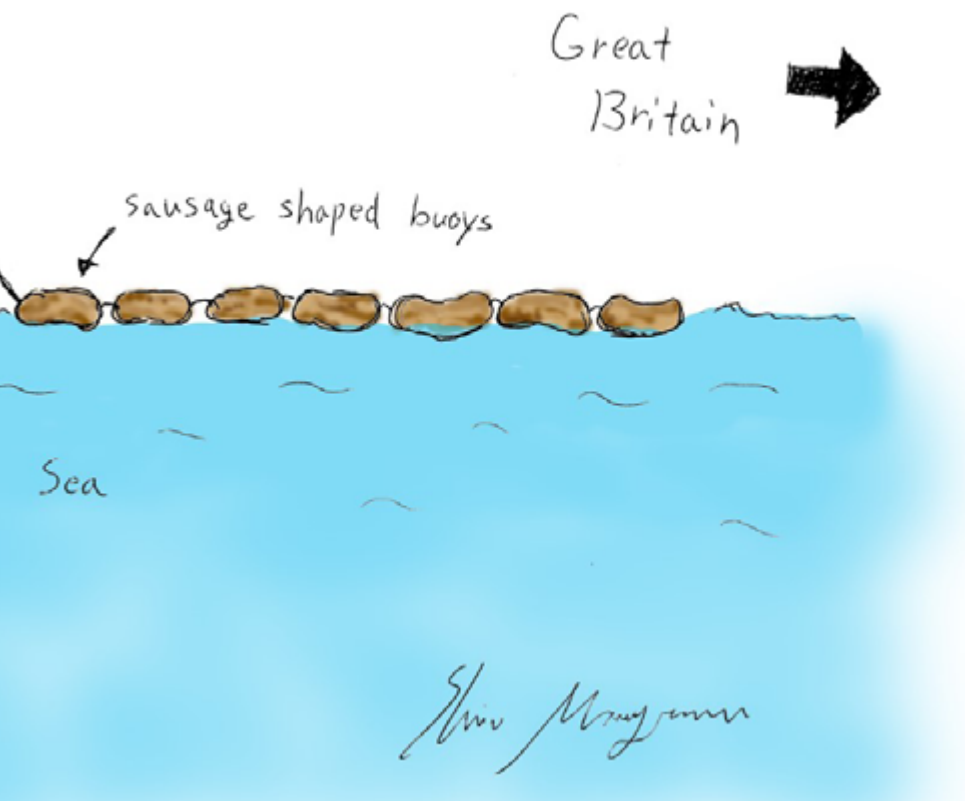

ar leith sin ina dtig leis a cheistiú an dóigh ar féidir leis na fórsaí polaitiúla ceannasacha atá thart orainn tionchar a imirt ar an fhéiniúlacht.

After Brexit, under the Northern Ireland Protocol it was agreed that Northern Ireland would continue to follow EU rules on product standards to prevent checks along the border. Instead, inspections on goods entering Northern Ireland from Great Britain would take place at Northern Irish



ports. This has prompted criticism that a new border has been created in the Irish Sea. Under EU food safety rules, sausages are no longer allowed to enter Northern Ireland from Great Britain. Belfast-based, Japanese artist Shiro Masuyama has realized a new social intervention using sausages to highlight this Irish Sea Border which was created after Brexit.

Shiro Masuyama was born in Tokyo. Following international residencies in the Irish Museum of Modern Art and Flax Art Studios, Masuyama moved to Belfast, where he's been based ever since. As a Japanese artist who has settled in Belfast, he's in a unique position to question how identity can be influenced by the dominant political forces surrounding us.

Is ann do dhá spás ag an am chéanna - spás taobh istigh de spás; is ionann sin agus an dánlann féin agus an Spás *Estranged* feadh a himill.

Themes explored in Cleary's work arise from a misogynistic culture that has been ingrained in Irish society for decades.

*Estranged* is a large site-specific installation made from deconstructed domestic objects that are painted pink and are then stacked vertically in suffocating layers. The concept behind the work arises as a reaction to female entrapment in the home.



This layered assemblage of flattened and repurposed domestic fixtures lines the gallery walls acting as a type of obstacle that serves as a tangible representation of that invisible barrier experienced by those within the realm of abuse. Domestic abuse occurs within a physical arena with far reaching implications within the psychological.

*Estranged* is a tangible response to this. Body & mind become estranged, a disembodied reaction to abuse. Two spaces exist simultaneously, a space within a space; that of the gallery itself and the *Estranged* Space that lines its perimeter.

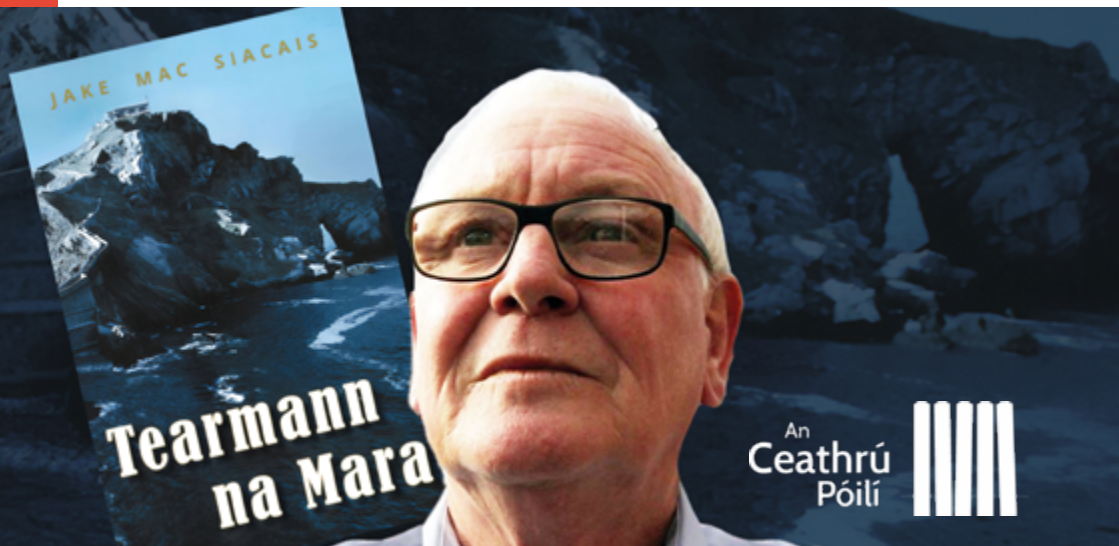
