Belfast TradFest le Laoise Kelly, Aisling Lyons, Lauren O'Neill, Una Ní Mhonacháin, Daithí Gormley & Tiarnán Ó Duinnchinn (MC)

I Ócайд cheithre lá, 11 – 14 lúil 1792, ab ea ‘Féile Chruitirí Bhéal Feirste’ nó ‘The Belfast Harpers Assembly’ mar a thug scríbhneoirí ná linne sin air, a d’eagraigh Preispitéirigh ar bhaill den lucht trádála iad, an Dr. James McDonnell, Robert Bradshaw agus Henry Joy (úinéir an Belfast Newsletter agus uncail Henry Joy McCracken). Ba é an aidhm a bhí leis ná suim a athbheochan i gceol na cruite agus ceol na gcruitirí a bhailiú agus taifead a dhéanamh ar a stíl sheinnte do na glúnta a bhí le teacht. An rud a rabhthas ag súil leis a bheith ina athbheochan, ba slán leis an sean-trádisiún é i ndáiríre. D’fhreastail duine dhéag de chruitirí ar an fhéile. Bhí seachtaí acu dall. Bhí an duine ba shine,

Denis Hempson (1695 -1807) as Doire, 97 bliain d’aois. B'eisean an t-aon duine acu a bhain úsáid as an stíl ársa agus é ag seinm leis na hingne. Ba é an rud ba thábhachtaí ar fad a tharla ag an fhéile ná gur fostáodh fear óg as Ard Mhacha darbh ainm Edward Bunting (1773-1843) le ceol na gcruitirí a scriobh síos, agus le nótáí a dhéanamh ar a dtéicníí uirlise. Chaith sé an chuid eile dá shaol ag bailiú agus ag caomhnú an cheoil Ghaelaigh. D’fhoilsigh sé trí imleabhar ceoil mar chnuasach, dar teideal ‘The Ancient Music of Ireland’.

Anocht, tugann muid aitheantas don imeacht sin agus do bhailiúchán Bunting.

Deirtear gurb í Laoise Kelly an cruitire is suntasaí dá glúin agus gur ceannródaí í maidir le stíl úr chruitireachta uirlise a chur chun cinn – stíl atá le cluinstín ar níos mó ná 70 albam, lena n-áirítear The Chieftains, Seamus Heaney, Christy Moore agus Sharon Shannon.

Is ceoltóir agus cumadóir ó chontae an Chláir í Aisling Lyons a bhfuil go leor gradam buaite aici. Bhain sí Craobh na hÉireann 8 n-uaire, chuaigh sí ar an stáitse go hidirnáisiúnta agus d'oirbhrigh sí in éineacht le taibheoirí agus ceoltóirí mór le rá ar thionscadail éagsúla.

Agus léirithe ar an stáitse agus cur i láthair ceachtanna déanta aici fud fad na hÉireann agus go hidirnáisiúnta, is cruitire traidisiúnta í Lauren O'Neill a bhfuil an-tóir uirthi.

Is cruitire, cumadóir, taighdeoir agus ealaiontóir fuaime ó Bhéal Feirste í Una Monaghan. Cuimsónn saothar s'aicise ceol Gaelach atá trialach, traidisiúnta agus tobchumtha chomh maith le leictreonaid bheo.

Deirtear go bhfuil Daithí Gormley ar na boscadóirí dá ghlúin ar an Bhosca Cnaipí. Tá stór mór ceoil aige atá fréamhaithe in oidhreacht cheoil shaibhir a chontae dúchais, Contae Shligigh.

Tá cnuasach mór albam taifeadta ag Tiarnán Ó Duinnchinn ó Chontae Mhuineacháin agus go leor oibre déanta

aige ar theilifís, i scannán agus in amharclanna, chomh maith le seónna agus féilte a dhéanamh ar fud an domhain. Tá obair déanta aige le ceoltóirí éagsúla lena n-áirítear Hazel O'Connor, an racgrúpa Vards ón Danmhairg agus ceoltóirí amhráin Ghaeilge.

Belfast TradFest:

The Belfast Harpers' Festival

The Belfast Harp Festival, called by contemporary writers “The Belfast Harpers Assembly”, 11–14 July 1792, was a four-day event organised by merchant class Presbyterians Dr. James McDonnell, Robert Bradshaw and Henry Joy, (proprietor of the Belfast News-Letter and uncle to Henry Joy McCracken). Its purpose was to revive an interest in harp music and to collect the music of the harpers and note their style of playing for future generations. What was hoped would be a revival, proved to be a farewell to the old tradition. Eleven harpers attended. Seven were blind. The eldest, Denis Hempson (1695–1807) from Derry, was 97. He was the only one to use the ancient way of playing with the fingernails. By far the most important thing that happened at the festival was that a young man from Armagh named Edward Bunting (1773–1843), was employed to write down the music of the harpers, and to make notes on their instrumental techniques. He dedicated the rest of his life to collecting and preserving Irish music. He published three volumes of music, collectively known as the Ancient Music of Ireland.

Tonight we pay tribute to that event and the Bunting Collection.

Laoise Kelly is described as the most significant harper of her generation and has pioneered a new style of driving instrumental harping which can be heard on over 70 albums including The Chieftains, Seamus Heaney, Christy Moore and Sharon Shannon.

Aisling Lyons is a multi-award-winning musician and composer from county Clare. She is the holder of 8 All-Ireland titles, has performed internationally and collaborated with distinguished artists and musicians in various projects.

Lauren O'Neill is a highly sought-after traditional harper who has performed and taught across Ireland and Internationally.

Úna Monaghan is a harper, composer, researcher and sound artist from Belfast. Her work combines experimental, traditional Irish and improvised music and live electronics.

Daithí Gormley is regarded as one of the most accomplished Button Accordion players of his generation, he holds an extensive musical repertoire steeped in the rich musical heritage of his native county Sligo.

Tiarnán Ó Duinnchinn from Monaghan has an extensive portfolio of albums, TV, film & theatre as well as performing at festivals and concerts worldwide. He has worked with various artists as diverse as Hazel O Connor, Vards, Danish rock singers and Gaelic singers.

TOMAS MONTEIRO SLABHRA NA GCUIMHNÍ CHAIN OF MEMORIES

Sa taispeántas seo, pléifear téamaí an naisc i gcomhthéacs na hintinne agus gnéasachtaí aiteacha. Fiosrófar an ghnéasacht agus an grá tríd an lionsa aiteach agus mar a tharlaíonn naisc agus mar a chruthaíonn daoine aiteacha a dtéaghlaigh agus a n-áit chónaithe leo. Fiosraítear an dóigh a gcruthaíonn eispéis agus mar a dhéantar slabhra níos mó de na naisc seo. De réir mar a chuirtear leis an slabhra, féadann sé pointí níos laige a chruthú. Smaoiním ar chuimhní cinn agus ar m'íntinn

mar shlabhra cuimhní, idir mhaith agus olc. I saothair a rinne mé san am a chuaigh thart, scrúdaigh mé tráma na mí-úsáide gnéis agus an fhreagairt a bhí ag mo cholainn air sin agus mar a mhúnlaigh an t-eispéireas trámach mé.

Nuair a thosaigh mé a smaoineamh orm féin, ba mhian liom an taispeántas seo a chruthú a léiríonn m'íntinn agus an dóigh a mbíonn eispéis ag daoine a mhúnlaíonn sinn. Le húsáid na ceirmeachta, na fuaimé agus meáin eile, bhí mé ábalta seo a chruthú ina léirítear eispéis éagsúla, maith agus olc araoon. Fulraigíonn an chuid is mó de dhaoine aiteacha tráma ar feadh a saoil agus ba mhian liom na mothúcháin sin a léiriú mar eispéisír chrúa, láidre. Fiosraítear

i saothar an taispeántais, idir ábhair amhairc agus téacs, na heispéiris, na smaointe agus an trúma sin. Máiilé lúb a rinneadh de láimh an príomhshaothar, a aistríonn ó chré dhuhb go cré bhán agus ina bhfuil 400 nasc.

This exhibition will talk about the themes of connection in the context of the mind and queer sexualities. This show will explore sexuality and love through the queer lens exploring how connections occur and how queer people create and live with their chosen family. How experiences create links and how these links become a larger chain and as the chain gets larger it can also create weaker points. I think of memories and my mind as a chain, a chain of memories from the good ones to the bad ones. In my past works I explored the trauma of sexual abuse and how my body reacted and how that traumatic experience shaped me.

When I started to think about this show I wanted it to represent my mind and how we connect and choose our family and create connections. Using ceramics, audio, and other media, I succeeded in creating a show which reveals various experiences, good and bad. Most queer people experience trauma throughout their lives and I wanted to show those feelings as cruel, powerful experiences. Through visual materials and text, the work in this exhibition explores the experiences and thoughts of that trauma. The main piece of the work is a handmade chain mail containing 400 links that changes from black clay to white clay.

Beathaisnéis | Bio

In go leor den saothar a rinne mé ar na mallaibh, ní hé amháin go scrúdaítear smaointe ealaíontóra óig, aitigh a bhíonn á fhiosrú féin agus a smaointe faoina bheith aiteach ach, lena chois sin, féachtar le ciall a bhaint as eispéiris thrámacha – mí-úsáid mheabhrach, fhisiciúil agus ghnéis – a tharla mar gheall ar an aiteachas. A lán den saothar a rinne mé ar na mallaibh, tá sé bunaithe ar an smaoineamh gur soitheach ceirmeach é an corp agus úsáidtear an péineas le troid in éadan an nós atá ann cruth coirp a thabhairt do nithe. Is iondúil go nglactar leis na soithí a chruthaím mar nithe baineanna agus le cur ina éadan sin, roghnáim an péineas a úsáid leis an inscne a bhronnann an tsochaí ar na soithí a chealú. Tugann taispeántas den chineál seo saothair ardán d'eispéireas na mí-úsáide gnéis. Amach anseo, fiosróidh mé a thuilleadh smaointe ar an ghnéasacht agus ar an áilios agus mé ag breathnú ar theicníci agus ar shaothair sheanré a rinne ealaíontóirí aiteacha eile.

A lot of my recent work not only explores the ideas of a young queer artist who is self-exploring ideas of being queer but also tries to make sense at the same time of traumatic experiences – mental, physical and sexual abuse – brought about by being queer. A lot of my recent work works with the ideas of the body as a ceramic vessel and the use of the penis to create and fight the idea of a body shape given to an object. The vessels I create typically seen as feminine and to counteract it, I choose to use the penis object to take away the given gender of the vessels by society. That same type of work also works and showcases the experiences of sexual abuse. My future work will explore more on ideas of sexuality and desire while looking at vintage techniques and vintage works done by other queer artists.



An gciallaíonn an focal Béarla HOMING (a) baile a chruthú (briathar) nó (b) cur síos ar dhiúracán dirithe ar thargaid (aid.) — agus, mar sin de, an döigh é le baile a scriosadh?

Sna grianghraif in HOMING, an chéad seó aonair ag Lane Shipsey, cuardaítear na freagraí ar na ceisteanna seo. Tugtar amharc leithleach, pearsanta agus, in amanna, greannmhar ar an bhaile, ar homing agus ar na döigheanna a smaoinímid ar an bhaile. And what do we feel when the place we live in could easily be someplace else? Is the answer all in the eye of the beholder? Come see the show, and write a line in the HOMING notebook with your answer(s).



4D MOUND NETWORK

Is taispeántas aonair é 4D MOUND NETWORK de chuid Jennifer Mehigan, ina ndéantar íomhána trí úsáid péinte, cártaí grafaice agus intleacht shaorga. Tá sé mar a bheadh dírbheathaisnéis ann, ina dtíteann reiligi, cartlanna, aislingí agus néaróisí isteach ina chéile agus iad ag comhoibriú, trasna amhlínte, le mná Éireannacha, nach maireann, le físeanna neamhspleáchas teibí a chruthú. Téann Jennifer siar go dtí an taighde a rinne sí ar mhínealaíona maisiúla sa Bhreatain sa 19ú haois (agus fócas ann ar ghluaiseacht na hEalaíne agus na Ceardaíochta agus ar an Bhráithreachas Réamh-Rafaeliteach) agus íomhána a fuarthas le huacht de shaol na hÉireann sa ré chéanna, agus breathnaíonn sí go grinn ar ról an ealaíontóra agus iad ag plé le smaointe faoi äilleacht, cumhacht, glaineacht agus éadaibhre.

4D MOUND NETWORK is a solo exhibition by Jennifer Mehigan, where images are made using paint, phones, graphics cards, and artificial intelligence. Autobiographical in nature, the show collapses graveyards, archives, daydreams and neuroses into each other, collaborating across timelines with deceased Irish women to create visions of autonomy in abstraction. Pulling largely from her research into British 19th century decorative fine arts (with a focus on the Arts and Crafts movement and the Pre-Raphaelite Brotherhood) and the image legacies of life in Ireland across the same century, Meighan examines the artist's role in managing ideas of beauty, power, purity, and futility.

Jennifer Mehigan is an artist and researcher based between Belfast and Limerick. Her work occupies a space where pop culture, painterly gestures, digital materiality, "public feelings" (after Ann Cvetcovich) and self-help literature can interact, allowing her to investigate, often through a non-human lens, how power manifests in the world. Recent exhibitions include Nightbloom Chokehold at Douglas Hyde Gallery 2 (2022), Crematorium 2, transmediale, Berlin (2021) and Crematorium, PS Squared, Belfast (2020).

The psyche is imbedded in the Natural world and communicates symbolically, this interconnected reality.

Bíonn an intinn beo sa choill.
Tá an spéir fairsing.

*The mind is alive in the forest.
The sky is expansive.*

Is ealaíontóir ildisciplineach i Petra Dominova a oibríonn le péinteáreacht, íomháanna gluaiste, ealaín fuaime, ealaín dhigiteach agus suiteáin. Trí úsáid an mhiotais agus

na híocónagrafaíochta pearsanta iomasaí, cruthaíonn sí saothar a tharraingíonn aird ar shraitheanna fo-chomhfhiosacha na hintinne, ina dtugtar suntas don siombalachas ina léirítear nasc le haontacht idir an Dúlra agus ár bhfreamhacha agus, ag an am céanna, ina bhfiosraítear smaointe a bhaineann le tuiscint, éicisíceolaíocht agus leis an mhisteachas.

Togann sí saolta atá fite fuaite ina chéile trí fhoirmeacha agus fhigiúrí orgánacha, agus iad báite i réaltacht chomhchoiteann chéadfach. Cruthaítear saothar maorga atá suite i dtimpeallacht thumthach agus a théann go díreach i bhfeidhm ar an lucht féachana. Agus muid ar tí scaradh lenár bhfreamhacha i ré seo na teicneolaíochta, is ann don intinn ársa bhunúsach go foill i réimse na hintinne agus na miotas. Leanann an saothar domhan nádúrtha na hintinne a chuireann ar fáil eispéireas níos suibhachtúla. Is ann do na saothair féin i spás tumthach, pearsanta, agus tugtar cuireadh don bhreathnóir tuilleadh a fhiosrú agus domhan dá gcuid féin a chruthu.

Is iarracht é an saothar seo atmaisfeáir an Dúlra, agus mar a shreabhann sé, a chur i láthair. Síneann sé a rithim isteach i scéal siombalach, in amanna gan chruth, amanna eile casta agus todhchaíoch. Mar an abhainn a nascann achan rud: sruth iomhánna agus fuaimeanna i ngréasán an domhain Nádúrtha agus na sícé, ag cruthú firinne osréalach, fhairsing.

Petra Dominova is a multidisciplinary artist working with painting, moving image, sound art, digital art and installation. With the use of myth and personal intuitive iconography, she creates work, that brings attention to the subconscious layers of the psyche, where significance is given to symbolism, depicting a connection to the unity of Nature and our roots, whilst also exploring ideas about consciousness, eco-psychology and mysticism. Building worlds, that are weaved together through organic forms and figures, submerged in a collective sensuous reality.

Creating work that is poised in an immersive environment and can be felt directly by the viewer. On the cusp of the divorce from our roots in an age of technology, the primitive mind still existing in the realm of instinct and myth. The work follows the intuitive world of the natural mind, which provides a more subjective experience. The individual works themselves, existing in an immersive, intimate space, inviting the viewer on a further exploration, hosting a world within themselves.

The work attempts to capture the atmosphere of Nature, and its flow. Extending its rhythm into a symbolic story, at times formless, other times complex and futuristic. Like a river connecting all. A stream of images and sounds in the network of the Natural world and the psyche, building a surreal, expansive reality.

D'fhás Patrick Kavanagh (1904-1967) aníos i Mucair, Inis Caoin, Contae Mhuineacháin. D'fhág sé an scoil nuair a bhí sé trí bliana déag d'oíos le cuidiú ar theirm na clainne agus le ceird an ghréasaí a fhoghlaim óna athair. Mar a dúirt sé é fein, 'go minic, thug mé iarraidh ar fhocail agus ar an véarsaíocht go dtí gur tháinig siad le bheith ar bhun agus barr mo shaoil.' In 1939, bhog sé go Baile Átha Cliath lena shaol a chaitheamh mar scribhneoir. Rinne go leor daoine beag den 'Bard tuathánach' mar phótaire diomasach, garbh, trodach, ach léirionn a chuid saothair spioradálacht dhomhain agus nádúr lách. Ní aithris é 'I Kavanagh' – atá bunaithe ar a chuid scríbhneoireachta féin – ach imscrúdú ar a shaol agus ar a fhís fheileata uathúil.

Patrick Kavanagh (1904-1967) grew up in Mucker, Inniskeen, Co. Monaghan. He left school at 13 to help on the home farm and learn the cobbler trade from his father. As he wrote himself, he 'innocently dabbled in words and rhymes and it became his life.' In 1939 he moved to Dublin to become a full time writer. Many dismissed the 'peasant Bard' as a vain, uncouth, aggressive drunk, yet his work reveals a deep spirituality and sensitive nature. 'I, Kavanagh' - compiled from his own writings- is not an impersonation of the man, but rather an exploration of his life and unique poetic vision.


