WORD FROM THE DIRECTOR

Go maire sí aois Choilm De Bhailis!

Ar ndóigh, leanfar leis na ranganna agus leis na gníomhaíochtaí óige, rudaí atá ag croílár obair na Cultúrlainne. Tá muid bródúil as caighdeán na ranganna anseo agus muid ag súil go mór le fáilte a chur roimh chairde, idir shean agus nua, ag dianchúrsa Liú Lúnasa agus ag na ranganna seachtainiúla a bheidh ag tosú arís i mí Meán Fómhair.

Liú Lúnasa began in the Cultúrlann and has given a forum to young Gaels to platform their interests here in West Belfast, adding to the fabric of Irish-language events island-wide. It is wonderful to see the festival bloom and to see the next generation of Irish speakers putting their stamp on it, continuing with the message of those first years - We want a life through Irish!

As always, we continue with our Irish classes for adults and arts-based activities for children. We are immensely proud of the standard of our Irish classes here in the Cultúrlann and look forward to welcoming back learners of all ages to take their next steps on their Irish language journey as well as those who are learning their first cúpla focal at our intensive course during Liú Lúnasa festival and at our weekly classes which begin again in September.

Dánlann Dillon and Na Ballaí Bána galleries are unique spaces in West Belfast that offer audiences the chance to enjoy visual art from all over the globe, and this season the walls of An Chultúrlann will celebrate different aspects of the human experience from the female torso to the immigrant experience, from love of

Irish cooking to the impact of our education on our lives with amazing artists including the winner of the Dillon Award, Janice Cherry, as well as Dominick McKeown, Colin Darke & Megan Luddy.

An Feirsteach **Neil Martin**, cumadóir ceoil agus ceoltóir a bhfuil clú idirnáisiúnta air, a bheas mar fhear a' tí don seó ar leith seo. Seinneadh a chuid saothair ar fud an domhain ó Ground Zero go Droichead Mostar agus an Royal Albert Hall chomh maith leis an Stáisiún Spáis Idirnáisiúnta. Dordveidhleadóir agus píobaire is ea é agus d'oibrigh sé leis an iliomad ceoltóirí cáiliúla.

Neil Martin from Belfast is a composer and musician with an international reputation, whose work has been performed across the world from Ground Zero to Mostar Bridge and the Royal Albert Hall, as well as being played on the International Space Station. A cellist and an Uilleann piper, he has worked with many leading musicians and will be the host for this concert.

Is as Contae an Chláir ó dhúchas do **Tara Howley** agus í oilte sa cheol chlasaiceach agus sa cheol thraidisiúnta araon. Tá a gairmré breac le mórghradaim agus le léirithe suntasacha, ina measc 7 mbliana le Riverdance agus taibhithe le ceoltóirí móriomrá ar nós Sir James Galway, Bill Whelan, Paddy Keenan agus Finbar Furey.

Tara Howley is native to County Clare and has a background in classical and traditional music. Her illustrious career is adorned with prestigious awards and notable performances, including 7 years leading Riverdance and featuring alongside legends such as Sir James Galway, Bill Whelan, Paddy Keenan, and Finbar Furey.

I gcontae Thír Eoghain a d'fhás **Dàibhidh Stiùbhard** aníos agus tá a ghuth fréamhaithe san áit rúndiamhair sin ina saolaítear na foclaí firéanta a bhaineann macalla as an chroí. Thug sé an chraobh leis i gcomórtas sinsir na hamhránaíochta traidisiúnta ag Fleá Thír Eoghain agus Fleá Uladh.

Dàibhidh Stiùbhard grew up in County Tyrone and he sings from that deep place within which the most meaningful and meant words are found. Dàibhidh is a senior traditional singing champion at the Tyrone and Ulster Fleadhs.

Cláiríneach é **Pádraig Rynne** ar fearr aithne air as a mháistreacht ar an chonsairtín agus as an chion fir atá déanta aige ar son cheol traidisiúnta comhaimseartha na hÉireann. Bhunaigh sé roinnt buíonta ceoil a d'imir mórthionchar ar thírdhreach nua-aimseartha an cheoil Éireannaigh, ina measc Cian, Guidewires, Triad, Atlantic Arc, Breen I Rynne I Murray agus an banna ceannródaíoch, Notify.

Pádraig Rynne from County Clare is best known for his virtuosic playing of the concertina and his significant contributions to contemporary traditional Irish music. He has founded several influential bands that have contributed to the modern landscape of Irish music, including Cian, Guidewires, Triad, Atlantic Arc, Breen I Rynne I Murray and the groundbreaking band Notify.

As Contae na Gaillimhe do **Mirella Murray** agus ba faoi threoir Mary Finn a d'fhoghlaim sí an cairdín pianó. Bíonn sí ag seinm ar ardáin idir náisiúnta agus idirnáisiúnta agus í aitheanta ag oirfidigh amhail Sharon Shannon, Lúnasa agus na Bumblebees mar thobar foinn neamhchoitianta, foinn atá bailithe aici agus í ar a camchuairt.

Mirella Murray hails from County Galway and learnt under the guidance of Mary Finn. Having performed nationally and internationally, artists such as Sharon Shannon, Lúnasa and the Bumblebees credit her as a source of uncommon melodies through her vast collection of tunes from her travels.

Ocht mbliana d'aois a bhí **Aimée Farrell Courtney** nuair a chéad chonacthas ar ardán í, sa Cheoláras Náisiúnta i mBaile Átha Cliath. Cuimsíonn a cuid seanma stíl iomráiteach thuisceanach tionlacain, mar aon le haonréid is dísréid rithimiúla spleodracha.

Aimée Farrell Courtney's debut performance was at the age of 8 at Dublin's National Concert Hall. Her dynamic playing ranges from a renowned sensitive style of accompaniment to electrifying rhythmic solos and duets.

Tháinig **John McIntyre** in inmhe agus é sáite i dteanga, in amhráin agus i gceol damhsa traidisiúnta iardheisceart Dhún na nGall. Ba mhínic é ar camchuart idirnáisiúnta chuig ardáin is féilte cáiliúla. D'oibir sé in éineacht le léiritheoirí a bhfuil clú domhanda orthu agus tá sé anois ag léiriú agus ag taifeadadh seánraí éagsúla ceoil.

John McIntyre grew up immersed in the language, songs and traditional dance music of southwest Donegal. He has toured extensively worldwide, on many famous stages and festivals, has worked alongside many world-renowned producers and is now producing and recording in many genres.

JANICE CHERRY Buaitéir Ghradam Dillon | *Dillon Award Recipient*

TORSOS: LEOCHAILEACHT AGUS MIANACH **TORSOS: VULNERABILITY AND RESILIENCE**

Ina léirithe ar an chabhloch sa taispeántas ‘Torsos: Leochaileacht agus Mianach’, déanann Janice Cherry scrúdú ar choincheap na cuimhne sinsearaí. Díríonn an bailiúchán de dhealbha ceirmeacha ar an tráma, ar an easpa cumhachta agus ar an leochaileacht le taobh an mhianaigh, an dóchais agus an ghrá. Is ártach é an cholainn bhaineann a choimeádann rúin, cuimhni cinn, an tráma agus an phian. Nil gnéithe aitheantais de dhíth orthu mar baineann tábhacht uilíoch leo. Léiríonn na dealbha tionchar fríotha seandálaíochta agus coirp phortach, agus scrúdaíonn siad teoiric Neamh-Chomhfhios Comhchoiteann Carl Jung. Déanann an soathar reatha seo machnamh ar eolas, scileanna agus mianach a chomhroinnt le taobh dúshláin agus tráma an tsaoil a chuirtear ar aghaidh chugainn ónár sinsear tríd an chuimhne. Tá muid leochaileach in aghaidh éifeachtaí an tráma ach, mar sin féin, tá mianach ollmhór ionainn iad a shárú agus an ceann is fearr a fháil orthu. Tugtar cuireadh don bhreathnóir machnamh a dhéanamh ar chion a sinsear féin i dtaca lena leochaileacht a shárú agus a neart a cheiliúradh trínár n-eispeireas daonna comhchoiteann.

Janice Cherry's exhibition, 'Torsos: Vulnerability and Resilience', explores the concept of ancestral memory through representations of female torsos. The collection of ceramic sculptures focuses on trauma, powerlessness and vulnerability balanced against resilience, hope and love. The female forms are vessels which hold secrets, memories, trauma and pain. They do not require identifying features as they carry universal relevance. The sculptures demonstrate influences of archaeological finds and bog bodies and explore Carl Jung's theory of the Collective Unconscious. This current body of work contemplates the sharing of knowledge, skills and resilience to life's challenges, and traumas passed on through memory from our ancestors. We are vulnerable to the effects of trauma yet possess enormous capacity to overcome and cope. The viewer is invited to consider the contribution which their own ancestors have made to their unique abilities to overcome and celebrate our vulnerabilities and strengths through our shared human experiences.

DOMINIC MCKEOWN

CAD É A CHUIR BAC ORT? WHAT HELD YOU BACK?

Le “Cad é a chuir bac ort” cuirfead bailiúchán saothar nua i láthair a eascraíonn ó shaothar a rinneadh le hábhair ó eispéiris san am a chuaigh thart agus eispéiris reatha, agus ó spásanna poiblí agus príobháideacha. Na dealbha agus na líníochtaí balla seo, cruthóidh siad sraith eagar a thugann an súgradh agus an teannas le chéile, agus iad á scrúdú trí réimse ábhair bhaile agus neamh-bhaile.

I dtaca le m'eispéaras pearsanta féin i gcórais oideachais, mar dhuine néara-éagsúil, bhí an súgradh ina chuid lárnaigh de m'fhorbairt. Spreagann na líníochtaí dealbhóireachta seo smaointe pearsanta ar éalúchas, ar idirghabháil agus ar struchtúr agus tá codarsnacht an teannais ina thaca ag gach saothar aonair ábharach.


Spreagann na dealbha agus na líníochtaí seo muid chun athcheangal a dhéanamh leis an dóigh a súgraíonn muid agus a ndéanann muid rudar a fhiosrú taobh istigh de mhúnlaí oideachais.

“What held you back?” will present a new body work stemming from the on-going engagement of working with materials from the past and present experiences, public and private spaces. These wall-based sculptures and drawings will form a series of arrangements that converge play and tension together as one, explored throughout an assortment of domestic and non-domestic materials.

Referring from my personal experiences in educational systems, as a neurodiverse person play has been an integral part of my development, these sculptural drawings trigger personal thoughts on escapism, intervention and structure as the looming contrast of tension supports each individual material composition. These sculptures and drawings encourage us to reconnect our perspectives on how we play and explore within models of education.

COLIN DARKE FUAIM FAOI CHEILT

Áirítear le *Fuaim faoi Cheilt* 3 shuiteáil/ fhísealaín, gach ceann acu bunaithe ar *With Hidden Noise* (1916) le Marcel Duchamp, ina bhfuil rud anaithnid ceilte.

In *Fuaim faoi Cheilt – 60 nóiméid/2.5 soicind*, cuimsítear seasca tiomántán crua a bhfuil fillteán amháin cosanta ag pasfhocal nach bhfuil ar eolas ag an ealaíontóir. Rinneadh gach tiomántán a phéinteáil ar feadh seasca soicind, sin seasca nóiméad de shaothar an ealaíontóra, a dhéanann tagairt do Marx agus é ag trácht ar theoiric luach an lucht saothair.

Is éard atá in *Fuaim faoi Cheilt - Sóisialachas agus Náisiúnachas na hÉireann* ná eangach de bhoscaí bronnantas déanta de chairtchlár. Ar na lipéid tá aiste James Connolly *Socialism and Irish Nationalism*, scríofa in 1897, agus aistrithe ag Seán Ó Muireagáin. Tá pingin de chuid na Breataine i ngach bosca acu, le forghabháil choilíneach agus an bhéim a chuir Connolly ar shaincheisteanna eacnamaíocha a léiriú.

In *Fuaim faoi Cheilt – Démocratie*, tá an dán den teideal chéanna le Arthur Rimbaud, a scríobhadh in 1873 agus a scrúdaíonn éilliú dhaonlathas an bourgeoisie, scríofa ar na lipéid fosta. Tá siad greamaithe de bhuidéil sháile an Atlantaigh, a thugann chun cuimhne stair imirce na hÉireann agus a phléann leis an reitric frith-inimirce atá le feiceáil sa lá atá inniu ann.

WITH HIDDEN NOISE

With Hidden Noise comprises three installation/video works, all based on Marcel Duchamp's *With Hidden Noise* (1916) which holds a concealed unknown object.

With Hidden Noise – 60 Minutes/2.5 Seconds consists of sixty hard drives, each with one password-protected file, unknown to the artist. Each drive has been painted on for sixty seconds, totalling sixty minutes of Darke's work, referencing Marx on the labour theory of value.

With Hidden Noise - Sóisialachas agus Náisiúnachas na hÉireann is a grid of card gift boxes. On their labels is James Connolly's 1897 essay *Socialism and Irish Nationalism*, translated by Seán Ó Muireagáin. Each box contains a British penny, signifying colonial occupation and Connolly's stressing of economic considerations.

With Hidden Noise – Démocratie is also written on labels - Arthur Rimbaud's 1873 poem, looking at the corruption of bourgeois democracy. They are attached to bottles of Atlantic water, referencing Ireland's history of migration and considering the anti-immigration rhetoric now taking place.


Joyce says that the soul of Ireland is trapped in a net; it is also collected there. To create ourselves we must reach into that fishing net, that lacework, that woven basket. Do our fingers catch in the gaps?

Owing a great debt to the scholarship of Martín Mac Con Iomaire, Bríd Mahon, Kevin Danaher, Jennie Moran and the thousands of voices woven into the Dúchas Schools collection, this exhibition explores and reimagines the patchwork history of cooking culture in Ireland. It does so in the hopes of easing a painful cultural memory of famine, fasting, hunger strikes, institutionalization and food insecurity, which today manifests in the prevalence of disordered eating and Ireland's disregard for the nutritional needs of those in our care.

Drawing on the aforementioned scholarship, persevering folklore, medieval Irish literature, traditional craft methods (patchworking, Irish lace), as well as the artist's love of cooking with her friends, the work develops a joyful visual language for Irish cooking.


